Welcome or welcome back to you all! I do hope you had a lovely summer despite the weather.

We have had a few meetings over the summer and reviewed our curriculum and routines. We always look to ensure we give the girls the very best education possible whilst giving them a wealth of experiences. After trialling Read Write Inc. in the summer term we have decided to roll out this phonic/reading programme from Nursery to Form II. This will provide the structure for the Literacy lessons for the first three days of each week. For Literacy each class will have access to three adults to enable comprehensive differentiation.

Nursery and Reception will be learning Spanish this year and from Form I upwards the girls will continue to have French as part of their curriculum too.

We have looked at the balance of Speaking and Listening within our English curriculum and made the decision that the term girls are involved in a play they will not have a class assembly. This will allow for more rehearsal time for the plays and the girls will still have two class assemblies a year. Form VI will not have a class assembly in the autumn term as they are preparing for important exams but will have one in the summer as well as their play. We also appreciate that getting to three class assemblies is challenging for working parents.

We have two new members of staff this term. Mr Lange will be covering Miss Toms' maternity leave for the year. He will be teaching the whole school and I know he has lots of super ideas for the music department this term. We have been overwhelmed by the number of girls wanting to take up individual music lessons. I know we now have a waiting list for piano lessons and we are trying our best to accommodate everyone who has requested lessons.

Mrs Dolling will be teaching a mixture of the Humanities to Forms IV, V and VI and is a great addition to our team.

Looking ahead, clubs start next week. Please be prompt picking up from clubs and with the Prep girls they should let the teacher running the club know if/when they are unable to attend the clubs.

On Tuesday we have our Form Information Evening at 7pm. We will all start off in the Jubilee Hall which is accessed by coming through the green gate and walking down the external steps to enter the Hall at the back of the building off the patio. We envisage the evening to be finished by 8pm. It is a great opportunity for the class teacher to talk through routines and for you to ask any questions. If you are unable to attend do let the Form teacher know so they can ensure you are aware of any information given out during the evening.

Please remember it is helpful if the girls in Form V and VI are dropped off to make their own way down into school in the morning, that way parking spaces are made available for the parents of the younger children. We do facilitate a slightly earlier drop off for Forms IV to VI as they are supervised in the Sport's Hall from 8.10am. Larks is still available from 7.35am for all ages.

Please remember to be considerate to our neighbours when parking and leave them enough space to manoeuvre in and out of their driveways and adhere to the no stopping on the yellow zig zags. Please do not attempt to do three point turns on this road or pull into our neighbours' driveways, you can do a short circuit using The Climb and Valley Road.
