For the parents of girls in Form IV and below please be aware for both Herts and Bucks there are fairly strict rules about how long you need to have lived in an area to qualify for catchment areas. If you are hoping for a state secondary school including Bucks grammar schools do familiarise yourself with the requirements. For example for Bucks you must be living in the house by the application date ie the October your daughter is in Form VI. St Clement Danes specifies you should have been in the current address for at least two years. So if you are thinking about moving into a catchment area don't leave it too late!

Many of the girls don't seem to have a hat, gloves &/or scarf in school. Having just returned from break duty it is chilly out there! The gloves can be any grey gloves but the hat and scarf should be the school ones. We have plenty in the second hand uniform shop, so do e-mail the office if you need to purchase some for your daughter.
